- In July 2020, the Hatboro-Horsham Board of School Directors adopted a resolution supporting the development of an anti-racist school climate. It states: “we must understand that racism is systemic, and it is unconsciously and consciously rooted into our institutions, policies, and practices.” What institutions, policies, and practices common in schools are examples of systemic racism? What can schools do to dismantle these?
- In his book Courageous Conversations about Race (2nd ed.), Glenn Singleton shares a quote from historian James Horton examining the notion in the American Declaration of Independence that “all men are created equal:”

“We are a society based on principles literally to die for, principles that are so wonderful that it brings tears to your eyes. But we are a society that so often allows itself to ignore those principles. We live in a kind of heightened state of anxiety because we know we are not what we could be or what we say we are (Singleton, 2015, p. 172).”

Does this quote relate to your reasons for wanting to be a teacher? What does it suggest about areas for curricular improvement within schools?
